Spelling Choice Grid – Year 2

- 1. Choose one of the activities from the Spelling Choice Grid.
- 2. All work should be done in your workbook or on paper.
- 3. Do not repeat the activity until all others have been done at least once.

Anagrams

Rearrange the letters in one of your spelling words to make a new word. You have to use all of the letters! Like this:-

but → tub

on \rightarrow no

over→ rove

*Do the same with 4 other spelling words.

Sentences

Choose 2 of you spelling words and use them **both** in the one sentence. Underline them. Make sure it makes sense!

*Do 2 more sentences like this with different spelling words.

Shape Words

Draw a big square on a piece of paper, now write your spelling words around the edge (perimeter) of your square. Turn you page around as you go around the corners!

Bubble writing

Write out your spelling words using

bubble font.

Shortest to Longest Word Sort

Find your shortest spelling words and write them in a group - circle and label
'2 or 3 letters'. Now find the next shortest words and do the same. Repeat until you have written your longest spelling word.

Jumble → Unjumble

Cut out small squares of paper. Choose a spelling word that you want to practise. Write one letter per square. Close your eyes and mix them up, then unjumble and glue into your workbook.

*Repeat with 5 words.

Sentence Starters

Use one of your spelling words as the *first* word in a sentence. Make sure it makes sense!

*Write 3 more sentences using spelling words to start the sentence.

Vowel Count

Circle all the vowels (a e i o u) in your spelling words with a coloured pencil.

Now write a list of spelling words with one vowel in it. Put a cloud around the list and label it

1 vowel.

*Now do the same for words with **2 vowels.**

Crossing Words

Write out one of your spelling words. Now find another spelling word that has at least one letter the same and cross the words like this:

home

e.

*Repeat with 6 more of your spelling words.
