Certainly, the engagement, maturity and adaptability of students has been very impressive.

Please remember that creative play can never be underestimated - it is an extremely valuable part of child development right through primary school. If your child is unable to complete set activities, do not be concerned. Let them create their own games, play lego, do colouring or craft and read books. Additional Zoom Meetings

From the beginning of Term 4 and until the year group returns to school, each class will run an additional Zoom Meeting. This will mean that your child will have access to up to three Zooms a week as follows:

Kindergarten - Term 4, Weeks 1-3

Year 1 - Term 4, Weeks 1-3

Monday: Language Zooms at various times Wednesday: Class Zoom at 9:30-10:00am Friday: Class Zoom at 9:30-10:00am Zoom meetings will discontinue when Year 1 students return to school.

Year 2 - Term 4, Weeks 1-4

Monday (weeks 1-3): Language Zooms at various times Wednesday: Class Zoom at 9:30-10:00am Friday: Class Zoom at 9:30-10:00am Zoom meetings will discontinue when Year 2 students return to school.

Class Zooms will continue to retain their focus on well-being. The school has many families who are choosing to work flexibly - completing tasks outside of normal school hours and on weekends. We also have many families who have to share devices between children and parents working from home who need to be available for their job at set times. This means that the delivery of content and lessons live is not practical or equitable. We are endeavouring to provide more short recorded instructional videos for students that can be watched at a time suitable for each family. These, combined with the extra Class Zoom and Language Zoom meetings will hopefully assist children over the final few weeks of *Learning from Home*.
