Art Work – Umbrella in the rain

This art work will be split over 2 weeks as it is quite detailed and time consuming.

Lesson 1 – you will follow steps 1 – 9.

Lesson 2 – you will follow steps 10-17.

You will need:-

- # 2 pieces of paper
- # scissors
- # sharpie or black texta
- # crayons, pencils or textas (cool colours – blue, green and purple)
- # glue
- # sticky tape
- # cereal box or any cardboard packaging you no longer need to put under your art work in case the sharpie or texta's go through.



Lesson 1 starts here

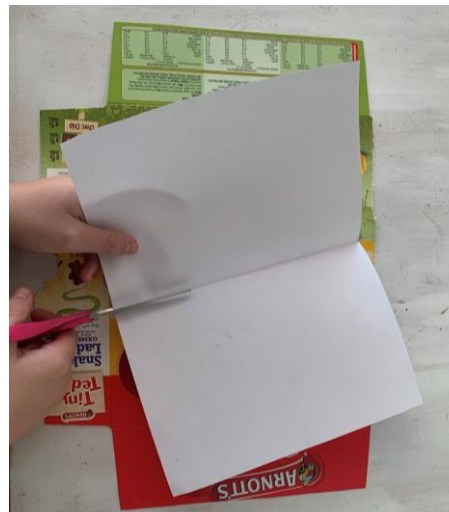
Step 1:

Take 1 piece of paper and fold it in half.



Step 2:

Cut along the fold.



Step 3:

Use 1 half and place it horizontally / landscape on top of your cereal box cardboard.





Step 4:

Using a black Sharpie, black texta or crayon. Start to add patterns across the page. You can do zig-zags, spots, lines, squiggles, hearts, stars etc



Step 5:

Add colour using texta, crayon or pencil (cool colours such as blue, green and purple).



Step 6:

Turn your piece of paper so that it is portrait / vertical and start to do little folds back and forth.



Step 7:

Continue to concertina, folding back and forth until you get to the end.



Step 8:

It should now look like this.



Step 9:

Scrunch one end together like this. Now wrap sticky tape around it to hold it together. Colour over it with your black texta.
