
Online reading lesson 3 - The Lorax






Some of the words tell us that the Once-ler was happy and hopeful and optimistic.


I want you to visualise the Once-ler; visualising brings him to life, engages your imagination and uses all of your senses.


I am going to put some of the words into a graphic organiser to help me to visualise the once-ler. \downarrow




The Once-ler had found the Truffula trees, he was happy and hopeful and joyous and getting busy making Thneeds.
