Can you think of a way to improve these sentences? Record your answers below:

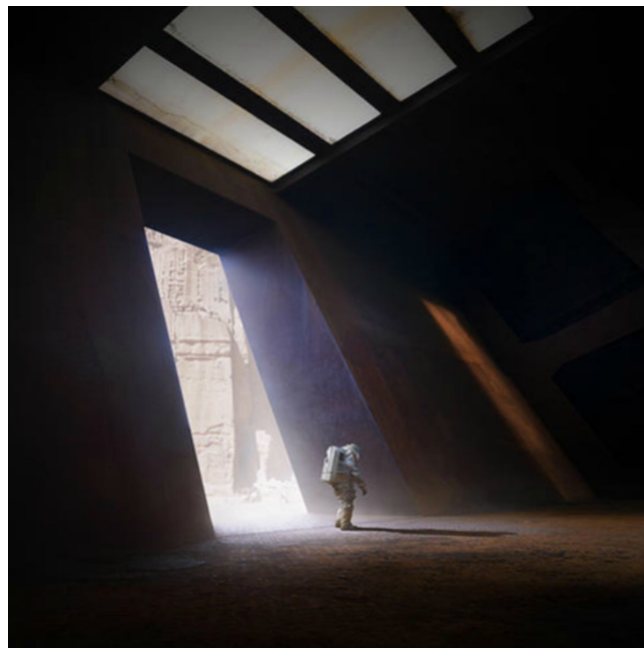
